

## **RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Each year, the superintendent shall develop and make available to all students, their parents and staff, student handbooks outlining student expectations, rights and responsibilities, and code of conduct. The school principal and staff shall confer at least annually to develop and/or review student conduct standards and the uniform enforcement of those standards as related to the established student handbooks.

All students who attend the Washington School for the Deaf (WSD) shall comply with the written policies, rules and regulations of the school, shall pursue the required course of studies, and shall submit to the authority of staff of the school, subject to such corrective action or punishment as the school officials shall determine.
