

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Thank you for your interest in having your child attend the Washington School for the Deaf.

The following steps need to be completed prior to the start of your child's 30-day diagnostic placement:

- 1) Completed "New Student Application" and "Health Information" packet returned
- 2) Visit to WSD campus by family
- 3) Release of information form sent to current school and the following information returned to WSD:
 - Current Summary Analysis and back up reports
 - Current IEP / transition / Functional Behavior Assessments/ Behavior intervention plans
 - Annual review of IEP (benchmarks)
 - Progress Reports (Academic / Behavior)
 - Transcripts for high school students
 - Immunization / Medical Records
 - Audiology Report
 - All attendance records
 - All behavior reports including detentions, referrals, suspensions, and other documents related to behaviors.
- 4) Parent interviewed for "Needs Assessment Inventory Interview" and "Safety Matrix"
- 5) Current school teacher or principal interviewed
- 6) Admissions team meets to determine eligibility for attending WSD based upon WSD Admissions policy (copy available from the Superintendent's office)
- 7) Meeting with current school district personnel and family to begin 30 school day diagnostic placement.
- 8) After the 30 school day diagnostic placement, an IEP placement meeting will be set to determine appropriate school placement for the student.
