This position is responsible for providing nursing services to children grades pre-K through 12th in a residential school setting at WSD. The LPN functions in an interdependent role to deliver care as directed, assist in the revision of care plans, especially to those who are medically fragile and collaborate with staff, teachers, parents and other health care personnel in delivering that care.

General Qualifications:

Graduation from an accredited Licensed Professional Nurse program and Washington State certification as an LPN.

Experience working with children in an education or health-care environment.

Ability to take direction from the Supervising Nurse and work collaboratively as well as independently.

Demonstrate ongoing commitment to learning and self-improvement and keep up-to-date with nursing information.
