Position Responsibilities:

This position is responsible for maintaining safe, reliable and efficient operations and maintenance of facilities at the Washington School for the Deaf (WSD). Positions at this level perform a variety of skilled work in the operation, maintenance, repair, and remodeling of buildings, grounds, machinery, mechanical facilities and equipment, and campus facilities, systems and equipment.

Duties Include:

- Perform general building repair work and preventative maintenance on buildings, HVAC systems, boilers, air compressors, and plumbing and sewer systems.
- Maintain, repair and/or replace belts, auxiliary pumps, air filters, and fire alarm system.
- Complete assigned work orders, document completed work information in the work order system.
- Regularly use drill press, sander, saw, pipe machine, welding machine, pressure washer, and hand tools.
- Order and store equipment and supplies.
- Perform fire drills and respond to emergencies.
- Repair doors, windows, locks, kitchen and laundry equipment, light switches, ballasts, etc. as needed.
