### **Position Responsibilities:**

This position will be responsible for operating the multi-media equipment in the Lloyd Auditorium on the WSD campus. This position will work on-call as needed depending on Lloyd Auditorium usage. Flexibility in regards to availability is required as work is scheduled based on facility use.

### **Duties Include:**

- Coordinates the operation and maintenance of the media systems and services including digital multi-media devices and their integration into systems in the newly renovated Lloyd Auditorium.
- Responsible for the technical digital multimedia and audio-visual electronic media systems.
- Operates the sound board and lighting system.
- Sets up microphones and digital projection systems.
- Coordinates with event planners to ensure effective operations (i.e. lighting and sound) specific to event.
- The Media Engineer will work with agency staff and students as well as outside public facility renters to operate the lighting, sound, and audio visual equipment in the auditorium that seats up to approximately 600 people.
