- The CEASD National Summit in Austin, Texas was very worthwhile. Many people were interested in what's happening in Washington. The Iowa School for the Deaf superintendent is interested in either bringing a group of people to Washington, possibly in conjunction with the April CDHL outreach meeting, or having a core group of people from CDHL/WSD go to Iowa so they can learn more about what we are doing.
- WSBC/WSCC (Western States Basketball Classic/Western States Cheerleading Classic) was held January 30 – February 3, at the Phoenix Day School for the Deaf. The WSD staff will take the information from the morning meeting and use it to help create goals for the next five years.

- Deaf Academic Bowl: The Western Regional Academic Bowl tournament February 15 – 18 was a resounding success. WSD's Tyler DeShaw did a masterful job with all the hosting responsibilities. Sixteen teams from Hawaii, California, Oregon, Washington, Montana, and Wyoming participated. Recruitment and hiring updates

- Krissy Walker accepted the new ASL Aide position. This position works in collaboration with the Bilingual Services Coordinator and ASL Specialist to further develop and strengthen the bilingual program. The recruitment to fill the newly vacated Teaching Assistant position closed February 22nd and a new hire will be announced soon.
- Bill Newell, Pre-K –12 Principal announced his plans to retire after the close of the 2012-2013 school year. Shauna Bilyeu, Assistant Principal, will become the Principal of the Elementary Department and will assume a supervisory role over related services personnel as of July 1, 2013. The recruitment announcement for Secondary Principal was posted on the State’s www.careers.wa.gov website and first round interviews of qualified candidates will begin March 4th.
- The residential department has welcomed new students and now requires additional staffing to maintain appropriate staff-to-student ratios in the cottages. Two non-permanent full-time Student Life Counselors are needed to fill positions through the end of the school year. The internal recruitment closed February 26th and the team is in the process of interviewing to fill those vacancies. Residential student numbers and ongoing staffing needs will be reviewed prior to the start of the 2013-2014 school year.
- Executive management is reviewing staffing needs and preparing to implement the transition plan to resume business and payroll functions as of July 1, 2013 as the contract with Small Agency Client Services will end June 30, 2013.
- Preparation for the upcoming 2013-2015 biennial budget has begun. The Leadership Team will discuss programmatic changes driving staffing needs and will work together with the Board to determine priorities and necessary budget allocations.

.Allotment Preparation:

- We have begun the process of preparing for allotment loading into the various state systems. Department leads are working with the Business Office to future organizational, equipment, travel, training and outside service provider needs for the 13/15 biennium. We do not anticipate an increase to general fund beyond the supplemental request filed in October 2012 to address the Charter Bus issues.
- The Outreach program has experience exponential growth during the current fiscal year. We are currently assessing the organizational changes that will be needed to support future growth and ensure for continuity of operations.

Current focus areas:

- 19H fund accrued expenditures: It was recently brought to our attention that DES has accrued anticipated expenditures in the fund causing the account to report as negative on all forms of reporting. After some communication with OFM, we have determined this is incorrect and needs to be corrected as soon as possible.
 - Background on 19H: The 19H fund was created via a legislative change that occurred in 2012. This fund is intended to support program growth in Outreach Service areas and allows the agency to carry over specifically defined funds from biennium to biennium. As this fund was modeled after Higher Education contingency funds, it is critical that our agency have a defined plan for what recoveries can be placed in this fund and how the funds will be used to support agency growth.
- Our payables processor at Small Agency Client Services will be transferring to another agency effective March 1, 2013. This may require some cross-training efforts to ensure for timely processing until the transition can take place.
