



Post High School Program

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Thank you for your interest in attending the Post High School Program (PHSP) at the Washington School for the Deaf (WSD).

To be considered for admission, you need to:

- Complete the “Post High School Program Application” and “Health Information” packet.
- Complete the background check form.
- If you have lived in Washington for the last 3 years, fill out the “Disclosure Statement” on page 2 of the Application Packet.
- If you have not lived in Washington for the last 3 years, you must get a federal background check (fingerprinted). You are responsible for all costs of the background check.
- Visit the WSD campus, including an interview with Post High School staff.
- Send the Release of Information form to last attended high school and ask that they send the following information to WSD:
 - √ Current Summary Analysis and back up reports (3 year evaluation)
 - √ Current IEP / Transition (FVE) / Functional Behavior Assessments/ Behavior Intervention Plans
 - √ Progress Reports (Academic / Behavior)
 - √ Transcripts from last high school attended
 - √ Immunization / Medical Records
 - √ Audiology Report
 - √ All behavior reports including detentions, referrals, suspensions, and other documents related to behaviors.

The PHSP admissions team will meet to determine your eligibility for the program based upon your application, the information received, and space availability.

If you are accepted into the program you will need to pay the following fees: \$100 non-refundable.
