WHAT

CamPAH is a Deaf-centric program for Deaf and Hard of Hearing youth between the age of 10-19 wanting to learn and/or improve their ski/snowboarding experience. Participants will be paired with trained and experienced coaches who are Deaf or have Deaf-souls. We welcome all languages and all abilities!

COST

CamPAH is offered at **no cost** to participants. This includes roundtrip transportation from Sisters to Hoodoo both days, lift tickets, instructions from a trained Deaf coach within a group setting, rental ski/snowboard equipment (if needed) on both Saturday and Sunday. This program does not include snacks, lunch or drinks. There is food available for purchase from the Hoodoo Ski Lodge cafeteria.

Note: Folks may self-identify as deaf, deafblind, deafplus, hard of hearing, a person with hearing loss, etc. OAS uses “deaf” in an all-inclusive manner. All abilities are welcome.
